Parents, we can all agree that student safety is a #1 priority for everyone! Please remember some important drop off and pick up procedures. We want all of our students to be safe:

*Keep the north drop off lane moving; please follow safety patrol and teacher instructions to pull forward or stop. Please pull all the way forward to the benches.

*The north parking lot (front of the school) is not an unloading zone. If you choose to use the parking lot, please park your car in a designated parking spot and walk your child to the crosswalk. The front crosswalk is the only place where anyone should be crossing the drop off lane.

*The west parking lot is reserved for school buses, daycare vans/buses, and faculty parking. Please do not use this area to drop off or pick up students.

*Remind your student to use sidewalks and crosswalks when walking to school. Students should not be crossing through parking lots without an adult.

Again, student safety is our top priority! By working together, I know that the drop off/pick up procedure can run smoothly!
