Chrome Book Pick Up

***You must have an appointment to pick up devices and you must have already requested a device through Google survey**

Please do not come to pick up your students' chrome books unless you have scheduled an appointment **through Skyward** and have requested chrome books **through the Google Survey**. We are busy prepping chrome books for those that have already requested. **If you don't have access to devices, you can request one here:**

To set an appointment time: Once logged into your Family Access, Click on the "Conference" Tab. Make sure you are clicking on the Chrome Book option and not Parent Teacher Conferences.

Sign up your oldest child only through Conferences. The Google Doc you complete will list all children in your family needing a Chrome Book. Again, **only the oldest child** will have a time slot to pick up **all** Chrome Books. **Chrome books must be picked up by a parent or guardian only.**

User Agreements need to be completed for each student picking up a Chrome Book. Parents are welcome to print the agreement from previous Skylerts (see our Foothills webpage: foothills.jordandistrict.org) or we will have them available upon Chrome Book pick up.

NEW: Internet Access- The district has set up hotspots in the parking lots at each school in the district. You may park in the parking lot if needed with your device to access the internet for student work completion. See previous Skylerts for information on companies offering free WIFI to families during these next couple of months.

Teacher Access

All teacher emails are located on the school web site. Contact individual teachers for specific questions about class assignments. Parents should also look for emails from teachers about assignments. Please contact me if you have any questions along the way and can't get ahold of your teacher.

NEW Breakfast and Lunch- Crossing guards will be available to help students safely obtain their meals from the school. **Any JSD child grades K-12 may pick up a meal – breakfast and lunch here at Foothills.** Please don't call us to let us know that you are picking up meals. We will have them ready. Meals will not be handed out to adults to pick up for their child. One meal will be handed to each child. Breakfast may be picked between 8-9am and lunch may be picked up between 11:00-12:00pm. Lunch numbers will be recorded upon pickup (they will not use the keypads).

Please pick up meals at the cafeteria doors next to Portable 13 (Mrs. Morales's portable). This is the door students use to exit to go to recess after eating in the cafeteria each day. DO NOT go to the front doors to pick up meals. Parents may drive through our west bus lane parking lot to drop off students to grab their meal. **You may bring in lunch money or continue to pay online for meals.**
