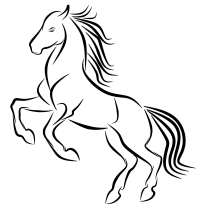

Teacher	1. Get ZERO NI's in citizenship on report card
Teacher	2. Become an expert by investigating a topic that interests you. Display your report in the classroom.
Teacher	3. Correctly label the world map provided. Instructions will be on the handout
Teacher	4. Independent Reading-minimum of 4,000 minutes for the school year
Teacher	5. Pass off a Math Goal set by teacher
Teacher	6. 80% or higher on 6 out of 8 math unit assessments
Teacher	7. Create and present a digital presentation
Teacher	8. Pass off 20 lessons in reading and 20 lessons in math for i-Ready
Teacher	9. Prepare and present a current event topic with accurate citation approved by a teacher
Teacher	10. Participate in school leadership roles ie: safety patrol, student council, lunch workers
Parent	11. Perform 10 random acts of kindness...write a paper telling your teacher what you did
Parent	12. Type 35 words per minute on typing.com and show a parent
Parent	13. Try to cook a new recipe
Parent	14. Watch an educational movie or show that relates to something you've learned about in class
Parent	15. Perform 8 or more hours of community service outside of your home. Track your hours and have a parent sign it off
Parent	16. Enter the PTA Reflections contest due by October 1, 2021. The theme is "I will change the world by..." to enter the reflections contest go to <a href="http://utahpta.org/ref">utahpta.org/ref</a>
