Mustang Pride is an optional school wide, extra-curricular award program. If a student desires to receive a Mustang Pride Award, it must be signed off by a teacher or parent by **May 5, 2023**:

*Complete 18-20 for a Gold Medal
Complete 16-17 for a Silver Medal
Complete 14-15 for a Bronze Medal*

Teacher	1. Be able to read all the words on the 2nd Grade Irregularly Spelled Word List.
Teacher	2. Receive all E's and S's in Work and Social Skills/Citizenship on all report cards.
Teacher	3. Receive an 80% or higher on 4 Math unit tests.
Teacher	4. Complete Rocket Math goal for the year as set by the teacher.
Teacher	5. Type 15 words/minute typing on typing.com
Teacher	6. Memorize and recite 8 of the monthly poems.
Teacher	7. Complete a "Show and Share" presentation.
Teacher	8. Memorize and label the continents and oceans on a map.
Teacher	9. Recognize and count combinations of coins up to \$2.
Teacher	10. Complete 1 book report or project for each grading period (total of 3). Two of the books will be narratives and one will be informational.
Parent	11. Read at least 300 minutes/month or 2100/year.
Parent	12. Perform 2 acts of service, such as Foothills day of service, visit the elderly, helping a neighbor, etc.
Parent	13. Interview a grandparent/parent/neighbor to understand what school was like when they were a child and write a report on it.
Parent	14. For one month, record the phases of the moon or the daily weather.
Parent	15. Enter the PTA Reflections contest, due by October 3, 2022. The theme is "Show Your Voice". To enter the reflections contest, go to utahpta.org/ref
Parent	16. Attend a cultural event (virtual or in-person) and write a paragraph about it. (museum, concert, etc.)
Parent	17. Run a 12 minute mile.
Parent	18. Watch an age appropriate science documentary related to plants/animals and write an informational piece based on the information they learned
Parent	19. Write and illustrate a short book (5 pages or more) associated with kindness.
Parent	20. Memorize and be able to write your full name, complete mailing address, phone number, and birthdate.

Teacher	2. Know addition and subtraction facts to 20 in Chinese.
Parent	3. Complete 100 minutes per month of Mandarin Matrix Reading at home.
