<b>Teacher</b>	<b>1.</b> Complete and turn in the Utah questions.
<b>Teacher</b>	<b>2.</b> Earn your Cursive License. (See your teacher for details.)
<b>Teacher</b>	<b>3.</b> Independent Reading - read at least 400 minutes a month for 7 months, or 2,800 minutes for the year.
<b>Teacher</b>	<b>4.</b> Complete Rocket Math Goal for the year, as set by the teacher.
<b>Teacher</b>	<b>5.</b> 80% or higher on 4 math unit tests.
<b>Teacher</b>	<b>6.</b> 90% or higher on 20 spelling tests.
<b>Teacher</b>	<b>7.</b> Achieve 25 words per minute on Typing.com
<b>Teacher</b>	<b>8.</b> Memorize and label Utah's 29 Counties on a map.
<b>Teacher</b>	<b>9.</b> Complete a Teacher's Choice assignment. (See your teacher for details.)
<b>Teacher</b>	<b>10.</b> Earn all E's or S's on Work and Social Skills on all report cards.
<b>Parent</b>	<b>11.</b> Plan and carry out a family activity, outing, project, lesson, etc. Write a reflection (at least one paragraph). Please include the type of activity, who attended, what you planned, how it went, etc.
<b>Parent</b>	<b>12.</b> Perform 4 or more hours of student-chosen service done outside of the home. Does not include chores or paid services.
<b>Parent</b>	<b>13.</b> Read at least 10 different books for the 4th Grade Read-O Chart.

<b>Parent</b>	<b>14.</b> Complete a family tree for at least three generations OR research a distant relative and write a two paragraph life biography.
<b>Parent</b>	<b>15.</b> Choose an authentic cultural restaurant or recipe that you have never tried before. Take pictures of you and your food. Write two paragraphs describing your experience and what you learned about that culture. What culture did you choose? What restaurant did you go to? What recipe did you cook? Did you use or eat any new spices or ingredients? Did you like the food? Would you recommend it?
<b>Parent</b>	<b>16.</b> Try a new hobby, sport, or skill. Practice it for at least 4 weeks. Afterwards, write a three paragraph reflective essay about your experience (i.e. What did you do? Things learned? Will you continue, why or why not.).
<b>Parent</b>	<b>17.</b> Participate in one school-wide event (School Carnival, STEM day, attend both Parent-Teacher Conferences, STEAM Night, etc.).
<b>Parent</b>	<b>18.</b> Complete a report on something Utah related (Utah Historical Site or National Park, environment, mountain man, pioneer, famous Utahn, current event, etc.). Prepare a 3-5 minute oral presentation with a visual aid (poster, PowerPoint, diorama, a book, etc.).
<b>Parent</b>	<b>19.</b> Enter the PTA Reflections contest, due by October 3, 2022. The theme is "Show Your Voice". To enter the reflections contest, go to <a href="http://utahpta.org/ref">utahpta.org/ref</a>
<b>Parent</b>	<b>20.</b> Write and mail/deliver at least 4 letters to family members who do not live with you: military veterans, first responders, pen pals, etc.
