Teacher	1. Learn all uppercase letter names.
Teacher	2. Learn all lowercase letter names.
Teacher	3. Learn all lowercase letter sounds.
Teacher	4. Be able to read 40 of 60 sight words without hesitation.
Teacher	5. Be able to add facts up to 10 with 80% accuracy.
Teacher	6. Be able to subtract facts up to 10 with 80% accuracy.
Teacher	7. Be able to count to 100.
Teacher	8. Get 80% or higher on 4 Math Unit Assessments.
Teacher	9. Be able to write their first and last name.
Teacher	10. To have all E's or S's for Citizenship goals on all report cards.
Parent	11. Read/Be read to 200 minutes per month/1,400 per year.
Parent	12. Service: Perform 3 acts of service and report to the class. Students may not count chores or paid jobs. (Examples include Foothills Day of Service, helping a neighbor, etc)
Parent	13. Interview a grandparent/parent/neighbor to understand what school was like when they were children. Share information with the class (verbally or by creating a drawing).
Parent	14. Enter the PTA Reflections contest, due by October 3, 2022. The theme is "Show Your Voice". To enter the reflections contest, go to <a href="http://utahpta.org/ref">utahpta.org/ref</a>
Parent	15. Share with class (verbally or by creating drawings), 2 books that were read at home.
Parent	16. Fitness goal: Exercise at least 20 minutes per day. (Can be physical play.)
Parent	17. Memorize a parent phone number.
Parent	18. Write 10 consonant-vowel-consonant (CVC) words. (Examples include cat, fog, man, fox)
Parent	19. Be able to tie shoes.
Parent	20. Learn 3 facts about an animal of choice and share with class (verbally or by creating a drawing).
